One hundred percent of the ticket sale proceeds will be split between two important, local non-profit organizations, Kern Valley Search And Rescue and SOS Dog Rescue. The event will be a *Brewers Invitational*, Beer and Music Festival, featuring Kern River Brewing Company, who will be selecting and inviting their favorite craft breweries from all over the state.

Not only that, but it brings in the folks that actually own the brewery or brew the beer and their intimate knowledge ensures that the customer gets the best experience possible. We look forward to hosting these world-class breweries in Kernville."

Over the years, Rivernook Campground has raised upwards of \$120,000.00 for local nonprofits. Amanda Pascoe, Owner of Rivernook Campground, had this to say about the ongoing festivals at their location, "When I took over the family business in 2015, there was a lot to adjust to and a lot to consider. Aside from maintaining the legacy my parents and grandparents had created, there was the question of where to take the business in the future. The most important role I thought the business could fulfill lay in looking outward and giving back to the community. This valley is an incredible, but underserved area and in supporting the truly necessary work that organizations like KVSAR and SOS are doing, I hope that Rivernook is doing its part in helping to make the Valley a better place for everyone."

These men and women put their lives on the line to help those who are lost, injured, and stranded in our wild and scenic river town. They dedicate a huge portion of their time to maintain a state of readiness to help save lives in the Kern River Valley.

The volunteers at SOS Dog Rescue work tirelessly to help dogs in our community. These amazing volunteers have made a big difference in our small town. Their everyday goals with the organization are: rescue and rehabilitate shelter dogs and place them in forever homes, educate on the importance of Spay and Neuter, and assist in the efforts of, "Making Kern No-Kill."

From the creation of the first local beer festival, Rockin River Beer and Music Festival, held in 2017, to Rivernook Campground's latest endeavor, the 2023 Brewers Invitational, Amanda Pascoe and the staff at Rivernook Campground remain motivated to continue the tradition of giving back to the Kern River Valley.
